Dear parents and guardians,

I wanted to make you aware that our school community (all grade levels) as well as the community at large is seeing many cases of pneumonia.

There has been news coverage about the recent uptick in cases of pneumonia and most cases seem to be related to a bacteria called Mycoplasma. Mycoplasma can cause cold symptoms, bronchitis and pneumonia. Mycoplasma pneumonia (also called walking pneumonia or atypical pneumonia) is a mild lung infection

caused by a bacteria called mycoplasma.

Mycoplasma infection is common in school age children. Symptoms can include a bothersome and long lasting cough, fatigue, sore throat, hoarseness, low-grade fever, headache, loss of appetite, chest pain and less commonly a bumpy red rash. It can take 1-4 weeks for symptoms to develop after exposure.

Mycoplasma is spread through coughing and sneezing so good respiratory hygiene can control the spread. Practice good hand washing and cover coughs and sneezes.

If your child has had cold symptoms for longer than a week, has a low grade fever, or complains of wheezing, shortness of breath or chest pain, please have them evaluated by their pediatrician or at Express Care. Some infections will resolve over time on their own but mycoplasma pneumonia may require antibiotics to improve.


